 - Network with other community providers and agencies to broaden the scope of our response

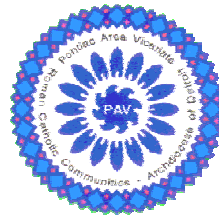
When you do it for the least of my brothers and sisters...


CCRT
