2006/2007 Pontiac Area Vicariate Objectives Pastoral Care/Implementation Ad Hoc Committee

Develop a Plan of Implementation of the Completed PAV Pastoral Care Study

- I. When: by January 14, 2008 present for acceptance the recommended PAV Pastoral Care Plan/Timeline to the Vicariate Pastoral Council.
- II. Objective: based on the Pastoral Care Study Recommendations develop a plan and timeline of implementation of Pastoral Care for the Pontiac Area Vicariate.
- III. Current Ad Hoc Committee Members: Deacon Ron Rohlman, Chair; Michael Harning (AOD) and Ann Suziedelis. Recommended other members: Fr. Chris Talbot, Lorraine Mordenski (Mercy Bellbrook) and Joe Soncrant (St. Andrew Parish).
- IV. Job Description of the Committee:
 - a. Phase I: develop a proposal for Implementation of Pastoral Care in the Pontiac Area Vicariate to include:
 - i. Committee members;
 - ii. Committee meeting schedule;
 - iii. Financing the Contracted Services.
 - b. Phase II: develop and implement a Survey for parishioners to complete in our PAV parishes regarding Pastoral Care Needs;
 - c. Phase III: based on both the recommendations of the Pastoral Care Study Report and the findings of the Parishioner based survey on Pastoral Care needs:
 - i. Review and prioritize the two study reports' recommendations;
 - ii. Report to and seek support for the prioritized recommendations from the PAV priests, VPC and PMA;
 - iii. Set up a plan and timeline for implementation of the recommendations based on the prioritization;
 - iv. Report to the PAV priests, VPC and PMA the PAV Pastoral Care Plan/Timeline of implementation by January 14, 2008.
- V. Current available resources:
 - a. AOD Department of Parish Life and Services including Michael McCallion's Office;
 - b. PAV hospital and parish Pastoral Care Ministers and Priests;
 - c. Other vicariates in the AOD who have established a Pastoral Care procedures for their vicariate;
 - d. Kathy Hasty and Mary Martin, Chairs of first PAV Pastoral Care Ad Hoc Committee.
